Dear members of the Lisieux community,

Our outdoor space continues to develop as a place of beauty, creativity and stimulation for learning. We are incredibly grateful to Tim Richmond, father of Claudia in Carmel D, for his inspirational work in making signage and a tee-pee for The Discovery Centre. With thanks also to parent Lauren Barton who worked with our students to design the wall murals, we now have a wonderful outdoor learning space. If you have a chance to come and see it you will be amazed.

One of our next projects will be to create a 'digging space/sandpit' near the cubby house at rear of The Carmel Centre. If any parents have skills in this area and would like to hear more about our design ideas, please let me know. We do have a landscaper available but if there are parents in our community with time and skills, we would love to discuss such projects with you first.

Last week we held an information session for educators interested in applying for teaching positions at Lisieux and were overwhelmed by the attendance of 70+ candidates. It is heartwarming to know that so many educators would like to know more about our learning community and will apply for roles in 2019. Obviously, we are in a very fortunate position to be able to shortlist the very best committed staff and I look forward to sharing more details about this in the coming weeks. At the same time, we have 'put the feelers out' for someone to join our community next year as a Language Assistant. The language immersion program we will adopt will see our students having a language lesson of 15 minutes every day and this language being integrated into our daily practice. At this stage we are considering several potential languages, but are most keen to appoint the right person to support the implementation of the program. The position may suit secondary school graduates, Gap year students, international students with a working visa, retired teachers and so on; fluency in a second language is a prerequisite. If you know someone who may suit the role, please encourage them to contact me.

FATHERS' DAY


Shhhhh! Don't tell Dad!!!
