Dear members of the Lisieux community,

Week 7 of Term 3 began with a beautiful, sunny Winter excursion to Fisho's Beach. How amazing it is to be able to take the 'whole school' (all staff as well as students, and several parents too) on a local excursion and to have such a happy community experience. The excursion began as we loaded on to the bus, drove a short distance to Fisho's Beach and commenced with beach meditation on the sand. We then shared a beach walk where the challenge was to talk to at least 6 different individuals (some children proudly talked to as many as 20!), before beginning a series of activity rotations: sand sculpting; photography; and, sketching. It was a fantastic way to start the week and I'd like to say how proud I was to take the students out and see them interacting politely and generously with one another and with local beach walkers too. Nazareth School, in partnership with St. Therese School and Victoria University, has successfully proceeded to the voting stage of the Government funded, Pick My Project grant. For a re-use site using local industry waste as community resources.

This project will establish a site to re-use local industry waste materials, traditionally sent to landfill, as resources for the community. This re-use site will be a catalyst for community-based workshops focused on engaging with local place and rethinking waste. The re-use centre will become a community cooperative, empowering families to actively contribute to the managing of the re-use centre and delivery of workshops using re-use materials.
