

FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear members of the Lisieux community,

This week in our staff meeting we focused on the topic of wellbeing within our learning community. We examined Lisieux's guiding statement which says:

At the heart of our school is our commitment to each student's wellbeing. We understand that the wellbeing of each individual is intrinsically linked to their personal and academic success.

As a staff team, we revisited the key principles of Positive Psychology and the reasons this philosophy suits our community. Because the practice of Positive Education looks different in each school setting, we have set ourselves the goal of determining our own school-specific domains of wellbeing and will continue to interpret and grow this plan. We look forward to sharing this with the wider community as it continues to emerge. While this background work goes on, what we see as educators at Lisieux is the growth in confidence of our students and their increasing flexibility, resilience and creativity. We would love to hear your feedback as parents /carers too – little snippets of how you have seen a growth mindset in action, for example.

Great progress is occurring in our new building with internal plastering and electrical work well under way. Furniture for the new space has been ordered and excitement is building. A decision has been made that The Carmel Centre will be utilised as our Foundation / Prep base in 2019 – this decision came about as we saw in practice what a nurturing and home-like environment was created in this space. Our intention is to house the 3 Prep classes in this space and to further develop the influence of the Reggio Emilia approach within The Carmel Centre, allowing us to achieve a flexible and creative setting for students as they transition to primary school. Stage One of the new learning space will accommodate Years 1-6 as well as a space for The Arts.

Next week is the final week of Term 3. Friday is Footy Colours Day and we will hold a sausage sizzle lunch. The term will conclude at the normal time of 3:15pm.
