Staff Conference

Our staff team experienced a powerful Positive Education two-day conference at the end of Term One. Led by Andrea Downie from Project Thrive, we discussed many relevant areas such as resilience, adaptability, the development of empathy and how to cultivate a gratitude mindset. A common theme was "Ubuntu", an African word which translates to mean "*I am because we are.*" We found this very meaningful in the context of the Lisieux community, as our growth as a school has been facilitated because of the incredible support of key stakeholders: parents, families, staff, students. It is an exciting time for our school as we continue to grow and enrich the initiatives we have begun. Thank you for your ongoing support. I will be absent from Tuesday-Friday next week to continue the professional development journey in relation to leading learning communities for a sustainable world. Again, this will be facilitated by Andrea Downie, who has a wealth of wisdom in this area.

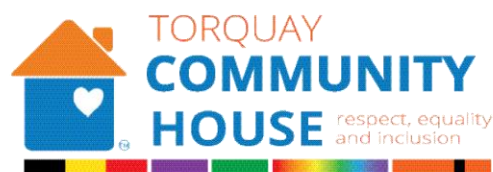
