FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear members of the Lisieux community,

Congratulations to our Year 6 students who were confirmed on Sunday at St Therese Church in a beautiful celebration led by Bishop Mark Edwards and Father Linh Tran. The sacrament of confirmation completes the sacrament of baptism and we pray for God's blessings on our young people as they come to age through this celebration.

Today we held our first Prep Transition Session for our 3 classes of Preps for 2020. There is a feeling of great excitement in the air as we look forward to growing our learning community with new families and new staff. The next Transition Session will take place on Wednesday 20 November with a final transition morning planned for Tuesday 10 December, when all children will progress to their 2020 class group and work with their 2020 educators.

The Building Sub-Committee has been meeting fortnightly and the plans for Stage 2 development are very close to being finalised. It has been a very positive experience working with Minx Architects and I feel confident that our next stage of building growth will provide sensational learning facilities for our students. In the interim, we have applied for two portables for 2020 to cater for our growing numbers. We will make every effort to ensure these spaces are well fitted-out for learning. Our intention is that one portable will be a Year 5/6 classroom with the second being an Art room.

If you follow our school on Facebook, you may have seen a post in the last week confirming camp details for next year. We are delighted to confirm that Year 5/6 will travel to Canberra between 10-13 March, visiting iconic national places such as the Institute of Sport, Parliament House, The Mint and Questacon. By visiting The National Capital, students will develop a deeper understanding of our Australian history and identity, civics and citizenship and how we are governed. For our Year 3/4 group, we are introducing a one-night camp to Sovereign Hill, Ballarat, in early November, where they will learn about Australian history in relation to the Gold Rush, immigration including the impact of Chinese culture, and will have the opportunity to pan for gold. It is our goal that both these opportunities will deepen students' learning experiences, as well as nurturing social and personal development.

Friday 13 December 9:30am. End of year mass.


Friday 13 December 2:30pm. Nativity play and Christmas carols. (Please note change of time from published calendar.)


