FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear members of the Lisieux community,

It is wonderful to be back at school after a period of illness. I'd like to thank all community members for your thoughts and good wishes, and for a warm welcome back this week. As this edition of The Tide is shared, our senior students and three members of staff are in Canberra, enjoying a wonderful tour of our capital city. We look forward to their safe return on Friday evening.

Families may be interested to know that every Wednesday morning at 8:15am, staff are invited to attend a brief 10 minute prayer / reflection time. We have found this to be a valuable means to nurture our own faith formation. The week we used The Parable of the Lost Coin and an artistic interpretation of this text as a stimulus for discussion. We talked about the perseverance of the woman in the story, in trying to locate her lost coin, and how, in our lives, that 'lost coin' or 'missing piece' can sometimes be a relationship with others, which makes us complete. As adults (and certainly in our role as educators), we also have the opportunity to be the 'lost coin' for those we work with. When learning for a child falls into place, and they experience the joy of understanding and success, this can also be like 'finding the lost coin', a cause for celebration.


REMINDER
