



FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear members of the Lisieux community,

It was a momentous occasion on Tuesday when our Year 3-6 students joined their younger fellow students in a return to school. The sounds of chatter and laughter now fill the school buildings and yard again and it is wonderful to have students back where they belong. There are many things that we have all learned during this time of lockdown and one is that human connection and a sense of belonging are so absolutely vital to our wellbeing. Knowing that Lisieux is 'our place' and that we are 'known and loved' in this space is a great feeling.

This week we welcome new Year 3 student, Eva Hageman. Eva has joined Miss Breuer's class and I know students and staff will help to ensure that Lisieux soon feels like home for Eva. Next week we will also be welcoming a new part-time addition to our staff team. Alex Kua is a registered psychologist and she will be working with us one day per fortnight to conduct educational assessments. This will be a wonderful resource for our learning community, as we will be able to conduct assessments in-house rather than waiting for lengthy referral processes in some cases. It will enable us to gather important data and tailor our educational responses for specific students. I look forward to introducing Alex to you in the near future.

This year our Term Two reports will look a little different due to the significant amount of home-based learning that has taken place in 2020. As you know, our educators had to adapt their style of teaching over Term 2 and students demonstrated great resourcefulness and flexibility in responding to this significant change. As a result of the changes to our education system in Semester One, it won't be possible for us to report with integrity about all areas of each student's academic learning progress for the first half of the school year.

This semester's written report will, therefore, focus on each student's:

- transition to the school year;
- engagement in remote home-based learning during Term Two;
- identified strengths in relation to the curriculum, both academic and non-academic;
- own self-reflection during this historic period in their life.


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
