FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear members of the Lisieux community,

I recently read a very insightful article about what school children may have 'missed out on' due to COVID, time away from school and peers and the challenges of 2020. Some would argue, and rightfully so, that our Preps and Year 6's in particular, have missed some key milestones. What the article reinforced for me, however, was what this year has offered for our children. They have certainly become more resilient and autonomous, more open to taking on new opportunities. For example, we've seen a greatly increased number of students riding bikes or scooters to school since home-based learning. Many have expressed gratitude for extra time with family members and the opportunity to strengthen relationships. The article also reminded me that students now have an increased capacity to learn from mistakes, problems and crises such as COVID, and manage to still reflect, 'that tomorrow will be a good day.' If there is a silver lining, that may be something we can be grateful for.

I'm very pleased to share a link to a new resource we have developed for families called 'Learning @ Lisieux'. Staff have been working on this throughout Term 2 and 3 and the finished booklet summarises both our educational philosophy at Lisieux and gives an insight into how our programs are structured. Some newly introduced language you will notice is 'Seeds for Growth' and some new programs we have named 'Discovery', 'Beach Discovery', 'Young Designers' and 'Sports Academy.' 
