### TO NOTE/ REMINDERS

#### To Note / Reminders (repeat reminder from last week) Smart Watches

In line with both our Acceptable ICT Use Agreement and our Privacy Policy, the wearing of **smart watches at school is not allowed at Lisieux**. Naturally parents can make their own decisions about whether their children have the maturity and responsibility to use these devices out of school hours, but during the school day, we closely monitor the use of technology and the wearing and / or use of the smart watches is not in line with our approach.

If your child has a smart watch, please ensure they do not wear it or bring it to school (regardless of whether it has limited functionality). Any child found to have such a device at school will be required to hand it in to Reception, where it will be safely stored until such time that a parent can collect it. We have had some subsequent discussions with families this week about smart watches, but wish to reiterate that this is a school policy and exceptions will not be made. Thank you in anticipation of your support in this matter.



Dear Families,

After a challenging past few months we now have the opportunity to celebrate the Sacraments as a Parish community.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be the first Sacrament to be celebrated this year in Term Two. Below is some general information specifically related to those candidates who are wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

A small note that many of the 2020 candidates have previously attended the Family Evening and Rite of Enrolment Mass last year. They are welcome to join both sessions again however, it is not compulsory.

#### **Reconciliation Family Evening**

A family formation night for the candidates and their parents/guardians only is scheduled for

• Wednesday 28th April at 7:00p.m at St Therese Church.

#### **Rite of Enrolment Name Mass**

The candidates receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation are required to attend a Parish Mass over the first weekend of May. As we have a larger number of candidates this year there will be three opportunities for candidates to attend a Parish Mass:

- Saturday 1st May 6:00pm at St Christopher's Church, Anglesea,
- Sunday 2nd May 8:45am at St Therese Church, Torquay and
- Sunday 2nd May 10:30am at Nazareth Church, Grovedale.

At this Mass, they will be formally enrolled and presented to the Parish community as young people preparing for the Sacrament.

#### **Celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation**

The candidates will receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at St Therese Church on the evening of

• Tuesday 22nd June at 4:30pm, 5:30pm, 6:30pm.

Families are invited to attend the celebration of this special Sacrament. At this stage only 4 people, including the Sacramental candidate of families are invited to attend the celebration.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will go ahead early next term according to current government guidelines. If the current restrictions change, further notice will be given.
