

Dear Families,

After a challenging past few months we now have the opportunity to celebrate the Sacraments as a community.

The Sacrament of Eucharist in our Parish will be celebrated this year in Term 3. Below is some general information specifically related to those candidates who are wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Eucharist. The dates and sessions may be adjusted to meet any future changes with regards to the government COVID safe guidelines. If changes occur, further notice will be given. The Sacrament of Eucharist is for children in grade 4 and 5 who have been baptised Catholic and completed their Sacrament of Reconciliation.

#### **Eucharist Family Evening**

A family formation evening for the candidates and their parents/guardians only is scheduled for Tuesday 20th July at 5:30pm at St Therese Church for Lisieux Primary School. The guidelines for this event will be 1 candidate + 1 parent = 2 people total

#### Rite of Enrolment of Name Mass

The candidates receiving the Sacrament of Eucharist are required to attend 1 of the Parish Masses over the 2 weeks in July and August. As we have a larger number of candidates this year there will be six opportunities for candidates to attend a Parish Mass:

#### Week 1:

week 1: Saturday 24th July 6pm at St Christopher's Church, Anglesea Sunday 25th July 8:45am at St Therese Church, Torquay Sunday 25th July 10:30am at Nazareth Church, Grovedale

#### Week 2:

Saturday 31st July 6pm at St Christopher's Church, Anglesea Sunday 1st August 8:45am at St Therese Church, Torquay Sunday 1st August 10:30am at Nazareth Church, Grovedale

At this Mass, they will be formally enrolled and presented to the parish community as young people preparing for the sacrament. The guidelines for this event will be 1 candidate + 1 parent = 2 people total

#### Celebrating the Sacrament of Eucharist

The Sacrament of Eucharist will be celebrated on Sunday 29th August 10.30am at St Therese Church, Torquay for Lisieux Primary School.

Based on the current COVID safe guidelines 1 candidate + 3 family members = 4 people total this may change to reflect the guidelines at the time.


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### Dare to Dream holiday bootcamp
