The celebration was led by Archbishop Peter Comensoli with representatives from our School Advisory Board and Surf Coast Council present, along with members of the original Steering Committee. In my address to the students, staff and guests present, I referenced Father Linh's vision of settling for nothing less than a perfect site with a sea view – for this we are all eternally grateful! Representative Megan Iannou from Melbourne Catholic Archdiocese Schools noted that of the hundreds of schools within the diocese, ours is completely unique and recognised widely for its setting and aesthetic design. 

I am pleased to announce the Big Summer Read is taking place at Geelong Regional Libraries these summer holidays!

The Big Summer Read aims to arrest the 'summer slide' by engaging children and their families in a fun and dynamic campaign through public libraries, supported with resources such as a user-friendly website, posters, downloadable activity sheets, stickers, badges—real and virtual.

Kids are encouraged to keep reading over the summer holidays with an incentivised program that uses Reanstack, a mobile app that rewards you for reading. When reading milestones are reached, kids earn 'badges' for their Reanstack profile and increase their chances of winning a prize! Participants need to log a minimum of 10 books and collect five activity badges to complete the challenge.

A competitive element with locally sourced prizes provides added incentive for participation. Distinctive statewide branding encourages participation in the program, whether children are at home or on holidays elsewhere in Victoria


