To encourage the most successful outcomes for students at school, it is vital to establish a positive home / school partnership. We encourage parents to feel welcome to make an appointment with your child's teacher, or a member of the school leadership team, should you wish to discuss any concerns you may have with your child's learning or social emotional development. Your child's teacher should be the first point of contact if you have any concerns and I recommend that you email them in the first instance, after which they can respond to you by phone or set up a meeting at a mutually convenient time. Please also know that I am always more than happy to assist with any concerns. You are always welcome to contact me by phone or email or make a time for a chat. We also encourage you to become involved in your child's education by assisting with reading programs, on excursions, Friday Flow, or special events. If you would like to be involved, please ensure you have a valid Working with Children Check.

Our weekly newsletter is our main source of communication with families. Please do read it each Thursday. In particular, the regular dates are important to note. Each Lisieux family should have received a hard copy annual calendar and you can also access this via our website under the drop-down tab 'Our School'. Each family will also receive a SeeSaw access code, as a means of staying in touch with what is happening in your child's classroom. You will also receive notifications of school excursions and activities via Operoo, an email correspondence. Coming up in Week 3 we will conduct Transition and Wellbeing Discussions via zoom, a great opportunity to chat with your child's teacher about your child.

It really is fantastic to be back on board for the new school year. We are looking forward to experiencing a wonderful school year together.

We are grateful for the compliance of families in ensuring that Year 3-6 students understand the importance of wearing masks at school. We ask that you ensure that your child brings a fresh mask/s each day and recommend it is named and / or easily identifiable if possible.

For the next four weeks, Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) will be available for collection from school once a fortnight. We aim to be able to provide one box per student each fortnight (initially we were not supplied with enough for one per child but hopefully this is now rectified). We encourage rapid testing to take place at home before school each Monday and Thursday. Lunch orders will be available from next Thursday 10 February, and on subsequent Thursdays throughout the term. Orders must be completed online by the preceding Tuesday.


















INFORMATION FOR PARENTS


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
