Our students are the reason for our existence and we delight in walking beside them as they further develop their strengths and passions.

Miss Laura Gillett joined our Lisieux team in 2020 as a Year 5/6 teacher. She has been a warm, supportive and caring classroom teacher and a friendly colleague. With her love of working with young adolescents, her appointment at Iona College will be a wonderful career decision, and we are grateful that she will be able to maintain connection with many of our Lisieux students there.

Mr Adrian Mancini joined us three years ago, coming from Shepparton, and has worked in Year 3/4 and more recently in Year 2. 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
