For those remembering mums who are no longer with us,


For the mums remembering children who have died,

Today is a day to honour the love and care associated with 'motherhood', wherever we have found it, and whatever ways we have found to cultivate it within ourselves.








I thoroughly enjoyed my first year at Lisieux. It is a wonderful school set in beautiful surroundings. I feel blessed to be a part of this community.






Get in quick before tickets sell out – sales close 7 June. Teams can go up to 8.
